SUBJECT: Transmittal of Letter Advisory Report — Interim
Audit Results of FedEx Transportation
Agreement (Report Number TR-LA-01-001)

During the Board of Governors' meeting on May 7, 2001, we brought to management's attention our initial audit observations about the transportation agreement between the Postal Service and FedEx. We indicated during the meeting that we would advise Postal Service management and the Board of Governors of significant issues and findings as they developed. Summarized below are some of the issues we discussed at the May meeting, additional observations, and our recommendations.

We recognize that the transportation agreement is a significant business decision for the Postal Service that has inherent financial and managerial risks. We believe our independent review adds significant value beyond those assessments provided by the external financial and legal consultants who analyzed the transportation agreement.

Our observations have been discussed with the former chief operating officer, the deputy chief counsel, and vice president, Network Operations Management.

Lowering cost and improving service have been two of the primary reasons Postal Service management has advocated replacing the existing multi-carrier network. Based on our work to-date, [REDACTED]


